

VITAMIN C SERUM



Why should you apply Vitamin C topically?

Vitamin C, when applied topically, safeguards the skin from free radicals that are produced when the skin is exposed to ultraviolet light or allowed to age naturally.

The Department of Dermatology at the Tulane University School of Medicine has discovered and supports the topical use of cosmeceuticals containing Vitamin C as an effective anti-aging antioxidant skin care product.

VITAMIN C (ASCORBIC ACID) AND PHOTO-AGED SKIN

According to another study conducted at the Department of Dermatology, University Hospital St Jacques, 25030 Besançon Cedex, France, it was concluded that topical application of 5% Vitamin C cream was an effective treatment for sun-damaged skin.

The study, conducted over a six-month period, led to a clinically apparent improvement of “photo-damaged skin”, suggesting a positive influence of topical vitamin C for sun-induced skin-aging.

Changes observed with the consistent use of a topical product containing 5% Vitamin C included a statistically significant improvement of hydration, wrinkles, glare and brown spots.

In addition, 5% Vitamin C, when applied topically on facial acne, produced a more significant reduction in inflammatory and non-inflammatory lesion counts than the acne treatment ‘Clindamycin’.
